### CITY HOLDS WORKSHOPS ON FUTURE ELK GROVE CIVIC CENTER

*Elk Grove, CA* – The City of Elk Grove is hosting three identical workshops this month to discuss ideas for the Civic Center site master plan in greater detail. Meetings will take place at Elk Grove City Hall on Thursday, October 9, at 6:30 p.m., Saturday, October 11, at 10 a.m. and Tuesday, October 28, at 6:30 p.m.

More than 75 acres of land on the south side of Elk Grove Boulevard will one day be the home of a new Civic Center and community park for the City of Elk Grove. Located between Big Horn Boulevard and Laguna Springs Drive, the site includes 20 acres for a new Civic Center and more than 56 acres for a park.

The multiple workshops will include live polling to help determine what types of uses and amenities should be included at the Civic Center. Following the community's lead, the design team from internationally renowned Zaha Hadid will begin design studies for the Civic Center.

“This is a tremendous opportunity to plan a cutting-edge landmark for Elk Grove that reflects the community’s vision,” said Mayor Gary Davis. “I highly encourage Elk Grove residents to provide feedback, participate in the workshops, and be involved with the process every step of the way.”

Extensive public outreach for the future Elk Grove Civic Center also includes a dedicated page on the City's website, online tools to solicit public feedback, and telephone surveys.
