GRANT LINE 99 INTERCHANGE GRAND OPENING SET FOR OCTOBER 14 *Congressman Dan Lungren to join city officials for ribbon cutting ceremony*

Elk Grove, CA – Congressman Dan Lungren will join key regional leaders and Elk Grove city officials in a ribbon cutting ceremony for the grand opening of the Grant Line Road/State Route 99 Interchange.

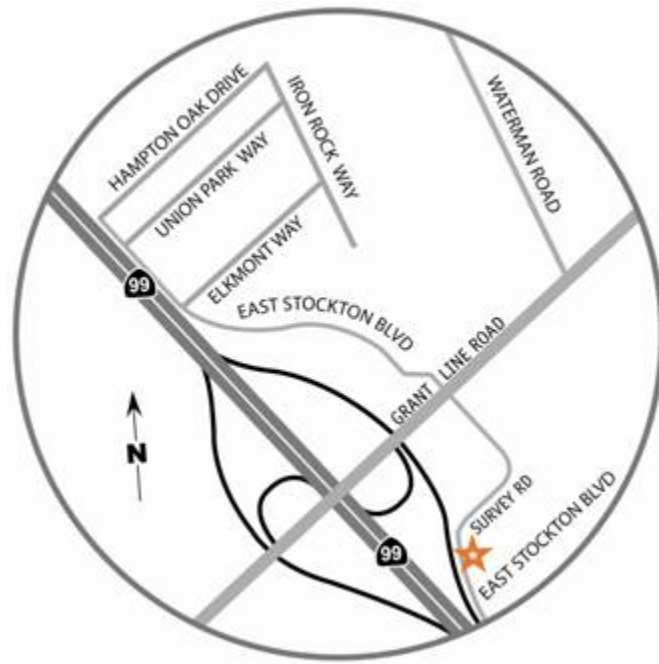
WHO: Congressman Dan Lungren, Elk Grove City officials, the Sacramento Transportation Authority, and regional and local stakeholders
WHAT: Celebration for the grand opening of the Grant Line Road/SR 99 Interchange
WHEN: Tuesday, October 14, 2008 at 10:00 a.m.
WHERE: Junction of Survey Road and East Stockton Boulevard (see map below)

The new Grant Line Road/SR 99 Interchange will provide safer freeway access, improve local and regional traffic flow, and improve mobility and access to existing and future businesses in the southern part of the City.

“The City is working aggressively to alleviate traffic congestion both in our community and for the greater Sacramento region,” said Mayor Gary Davis. “We are happy to be the first project in Sacramento County to complete construction with ‘new’ Measure A funds.”

The city invested more than \$80 million dollars on the project, made possible through “New” Measure A Sales Tax funds and Elk Grove development impact fees.
