PUBLIC INVITED TO VOTE ON POTENTIAL VETERAN STREET NAMING PROGRAM

Elk Grove, CA – The City of Elk Grove is currently exploring a potential new program that would recognize veterans and is seeking the public's input. The prospective veteran street naming program would give residents the ability to name a new street after a veteran that meets specific program criteria.

Residents are encouraged to vote for a preferred street sign design by October 17. After voting has concluded, the City Council will formally consider the veterans street naming program at a future City Council meeting.

It is important for residents to show their preference regarding the "look & feel" of these signs since the public will be responsible for the street naming.
