City Solicits Feedback on Draft Environmental Document for Elk Grove Intermodal Rail Station Master Plan

Elk Grove, CA – The City of Elk Grove is soliciting input on the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Elk Grove Intermodal Rail Station Master Plan. This is an environmental document developed in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). To provide information on the environmental document and receive comments from the public, a public meeting (open house format) will be held on February 23, 2010 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Elk Grove City Council Chambers (8400 Laguna Palms Way).

The subject of the environmental analysis is the proposed Intermodal Rail Station Master Plan. The project location is on the west side of Elk Grove – Florin Road south of Sheldon Road and north of Camden Drive. Major elements of the Master Plan scope include traffic improvements, rail passenger platform, parking lot, pedestrian/bicycle trail, bridge over Whitehouse Creek, and areas for possible future expansion.
