City's Building Department to Host Workshop for Development Community on April 5

Elk Grove, CA – The City of Elk Grove is taking major strides to provide top-notch service to the development community, and will be hosting a “meet and greet” workshop for contractors and developers on April 5.

The workshop, hosted by the City of Elk Grove’s Building and Safety Inspection Department, will provide an opportunity to meet with staff, ask questions about the City of Elk Grove building permit requirements and policies, and provide feedback to City staff about how to improve services. Staff will also provide a presentation on newly-effective California Title 24 Energy Code Requirements.

The workshop will also highlight enhanced scheduling flexibility for building inspection services in Elk Grove. The City recently began offering building inspections for homeowners the first Saturday of the month, and homeowners and contractors with the option to schedule early morning building inspections.

“The City is committed to improving business planning and approval processes,” said Mayor Sophia Scherman. “We encourage the development community to attend this workshop so that you will be prepared to start your project with the necessary information at your fingertips.”
