City Seeks Input on Ways to Address Climate Change and Sustainability at April 20 Workshop

Elk Grove, CA – The City of Elk Grove will hold a community workshop at City Hall on Tuesday, April 20, at 6 p.m. to seek public input on ways to address climate change through local improvements to air quality, energy efficiency and community health.

The meeting will be the first in a series on green issues that will be addressed in the Climate Action Plan (CAP) and the Sustainability Element of the General Plan Update (GPU).

“The goals and actions that will be outlined in these documents are intended to support a healthy and sustainable future for our City,” stated Mayor Sophia Scherman. “As always, we will be looking to the community to guide us in shaping these important policies.”

Each document, once completed, will contain policies and programs that are designed to help the City meet state legal requirements for greenhouse gas emissions reduction. The City will be holding a series of community workshops to get input from residents, businesses and organizations within Elk Grove.

This workshop will provide an opportunity for the community to learn about both projects and will allow the City to receive input about specific policy issues and opportunities the community would like the CAP and Sustainability Element to address.
