**New Bicycle Overpass Coming to Elk Grove**

In case you missed the news last week, the City of Elk Grove has secured a \$900,000 grant from Caltrans to build a pedestrian and bicycle bridge over Highway 99 at Elk Grove Boulevard. Slated to break ground in early 2011, the Elk Grove Creek/State Route 99 Trail Crossing Project will improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety, close a critical gap in the existing Elk Grove Creek Trail, and improve connectivity to many schools, parks, neighborhoods and commercial business areas.
