New Animal Services Ordinance Takes Effect Next Week

Starting next week, a new animal services ordinance takes effect to better protect the health and safety of Elk Grove pets. Starting September 23, dogs and cats must now have an anti-rabies vaccination and a microchip to be licensed by the City of Elk Grove. The ordinance also bans the sale of puppies and

kittens less than eight weeks of age. Starting October 1, new animal licensing fees also take effect. It will cost \$15 per year to license altered animals, and \$150 annually for unaltered animals. For more info, visit: www.elkgrovecity.org/animals/index.asp.
