New Animal Services Ordinance Takes Effect This Week

Starting September 23, a new animal services ordinance takes effect. Dogs and cats must now have an anti-rabies vaccination and a microchip to be licensed by the City of Elk Grove. The ordinance also bans the sale of puppies and kittens less than eight weeks of age. Starting October 1, it will cost \$15 per year to license altered animals, and \$150 annually for unaltered animals. For more info, visit:
