Elk Grove PD Wants you!

The Elk Grove Police Department is now accepting applications for the next Citizens' Academy, which begins February 10, 2010. The Citizens' Academy is a sixteen week program designed to inform and teach interested residents about the various aspects of municipal policing. The program covers procedures from patrol and investigations, vehicle operations, arrest and control techniques, 911 communications, code enforcement and animal control. The Citizens' Academy is free of charge and meets on Wednesday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Elk Grove Police Department. Participants must be at least 18 years of age, live or work in Elk Grove, and have no felony convictions (a background check will be completed on all applicants before entering the Citizens' Academy). Spay Day Appointment Line Opens January 23

Starting on Saturday, January 23, pet owners in Elk Grove can request an appointment to have their pets spayed or neutered at a deep discount as part of Spay Day Sacramento 2010. Appointments are required and must be made in advance starting on January 23 by calling (916) 808-SPAY [7729]. Families earning less than \$35,000 per year are eligible to have up to two cats or dogs spayed or neutered on Sunday, February 28. For just \$15 per cat and \$20 per dog, each animal receives approximately \$250 worth of services, including microchip ID, vaccinations and a flea preventive. Cash payment is required at time of appointment. Spay/neuter surgeries will take place at vet clinics throughout Sacramento, Yolo and Placer Counties. Demand for this event is high and appointments fill up fast, so eligible pet owners should call early. Spay Day, an annual event now in its eleventh year, is organized by the Sacramento Area Animal Coalition (SAAC), a nonprofit organization committed to eliminating pet overpopulation in the Sacramento area through aggressive spay/neuter efforts.
