Elk Grove is not only the site of the first free county public library in California, it is also the first in Sacramento County to make use of an automated materials handling system. City's FY 2010-11 Budget Now Online

Last week, the Elk Grove City Council passed a new balanced city budget of \$210.6 million for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010. The City balanced the budget by reducing operational expenses, organizational restructuring, suspending components of employee compensation and instituting eight furlough days a year for non-sworn City staff. The Council also approved a five-year, \$320 million capital improvement program, which includes funding for various construction projects in the City, including

the Grant Line Road widening and the future Elk Grove Civic Center. The budget can be viewed here:
