Kaiser Breaks Ground on New Elk Grove Facility

Kaiser Permanente has begun work on a \$38 million medical office building on Promenade Parkway in Elk Grove. Construction on the new 65,000-square-foot facility began last week. Scheduled to open in late 2011, the building will offer adult medicine, pediatrics, women's health, sports medicine, health education, a healthy living store and radiology, laboratory and pharmacy services.
