Speed Control Ballots to Hit Select Mailboxes This Week

The City of Elk Grove will be considering speed control measures on more than 30 streets in Elk Grove as part of the City's Speed Control Program. The program's goal is to improve neighborhood livability and safety by reducing the impact of traffic in residential neighborhoods. This week, ballots will be mailed to residents on select streets, based on input previously collected in the program. Every resident on the street section will have the opportunity to vote for or against the proposed speed control measures. The vote will decide whether or not the speed control measure will be evaluated for implementation for that street.
