### **City Offers Grant Application Workshop Feb. 9**

Non-profit organizations and local government entities serving the Elk Grove community are encouraged to apply for grant funding offered by the City of Elk Grove. For the 2012-13 fiscal year, up to \$402,000 is available through the City of Elk Grove's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Community Service Grant (CSG) programs. The City will hold a technical assistance workshop and public meeting on February 9 at 3:30 p.m. at Elk Grove City Hall, 8401 Laguna Palms Way. Staff will review eligibility requirements, the application process, answer technical questions and assist applicants. ### **National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey**

The National Center for Health Statistics, part of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, is conducting a major study of the health of persons living in the United States. Sacramento County has been selected once again as one of the survey locations to assess the health and nutrition status of children and adults and their needs for health care. This year they will be conducting the survey from January 26 through April 2, 2012. They anticipate about 455 people from Sacramento County will be asked to participate in the survey. Interviewers will be calling on designated households throughout the area. They will obtain the demographic information used to identify and select people for the examination.
