

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE CONCERNING COVERAGE OF DISABILITY INSURANCE ONLY DIRECTING THAT AN APPLICATION FOR ELECTIVE COVERAGE BE FILED WITH STATE OF CALIFORNIA EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, State Disability Insurance coverage may be approved for all present and future employees of the city; and

WHEREAS, the decision to participate in said program may be made by the City Council or in response to a petition signed by a majority of the employees, coverage of which must be elected for at least two complete calendar years; and,

WHEREAS, employee contributions for disability insurance are required at the rate established for each year up to the annual taxable wage limit and employee contributions are used exclusively to finance the state disability insurance program.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

That an application for election coverage be filed with the State of California Employment Development Department for coverage of Disability Insurance only under Section 709 of the California Unemployment Insurance Code.


