

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-54

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING A PETTY CASH FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove became an incorporated city on July 1, 2000;
and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove has need to establish a cash fund for incidental
office expenditures and for making change; and

WHEREAS, the amount of that fund shall be \$100.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council does hereby authorize the Finance Director to establish a Petty
Cash Fund and to disburse \$100 from the General Fund.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Petty Cash Fund shall be reimbursed as
