

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-57

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
APPROVING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR STATIONARY
HORN WARNING SYSTEMS WITH THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION
OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO EXECUTE IT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE


WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove desires to undertake a pilot program to test the effectiveness of Stationary Horn Warning Devices at various at-grade railroad crossings in Elk Grove in an effort to reduce the impact of noise to the neighboring community; and

WHEREAS, the at-grade railroad crossings at Grant Line Road, Elk Grove Boulevard, Elk Grove-Florin Road, Bond Road, Sheldon Road, and Calvine Road have been identified as desired locations by the City Council; and


WHEREAS, the Union Pacific Railroad has agreed to cooperate with the City of elk Grove and to support the filing of such application with the California Public Utilities Commission; and
