**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
INITIATING A ZONING AMENDMENT APPLICATION
FOR APN 127-0160-029**

WHEREAS, Max Siefker submitted a request for the City to rezone the subject property (APN 127-0160-029) from residential to recreation as identified in the Elk Grove Florin and Bond Road Special Planning Area Section 501-182(a) in order to donate the land to the Elk Grove Community Services District for a public park in memory of Mr. Del Meyer; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is the appropriate authority to initiate a zoning amendment in accordance with Section 115-11 of the Zoning Code; and


WHEREAS, initiation of a zoning amendment application is not considered a project requiring review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and

WHEREAS, the request to rezone the property for a public park would be beneficial to the general welfare of the citizens of Elk Grove.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Initiate a zoning amendment application to rezone a site from residential to recreation in order to allow the property owner to donate the land to the Elk Grove Community Services District for a public park and direct staff to process the application.
