A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE TO VACATE A 35 FOOT PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT AT THE LAGUNA BUSINESS PARK (ABANDONMENT PROCEEDING NUMBER EG-01-195)

WHEREAS, the City received a petition to vacate from owners of property within the City of Elk Grove requesting the City Council of the City of Elk Grove to consider vacation of the subject property; and

WHEREAS, a notice that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove would consider the proposed vacation at a Public Hearing was given in compliance with California Streets and Highways Code, Section 8300, et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the standards and procedures provided in the Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law, California Streets and Highways Code Section 8300 et seq., the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby declares its intention to vacate a public utility easement over Assessor's Parcel No.'s 116-0330-027, 116-0330-044, 116-0330-045, and 116-0330-046 specifically shown on the attached Exhibits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove Planning Department has reviewed this project and is recommending that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove find the vacation of the public utility easement as described in the attached exhibits exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15305 of the CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove Planning Department has determined that the vacation is consistent with the General Plan and all elements thereof.

- b. That the public utility easement is unnecessary for present or prospective public use because new easements will be provided once the parcels are developed; and
- c. That the public interest will be served by the herein vacation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the public utility easement over portions of the property shown on the attached Exhibit "A-1" is hereby vacated.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City Clerk of the Elk Grove City Council shall cause a certified copy of this Resolution of Vacation, attested by the Clerk under seal, to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Sacramento.


