4.1 SUBJECT: Pedestrian Upgrades (WAM010)

Kristin said this project is funded through HCIP grants. Rick is managing the project and it's currently under design. Hoping that bidding will be in the summer with construction following. The improvements will be at four locations of current crosswalks including upgraded curb ramps, ladder crosswalks, and flashing beacons. Ted asked if there will be an audio component and Rick said there would. The first location is at Laguna Park Drive at Ryland Trail near Foulks Ranch Elementary. The second and third locations are near Laguna Creek High School. The fourth is in eastern Elk Grove near Pleasant Grove High School. Bruce asked if they're push button activated and Rick said they were. They're on a 13ft pole and are solar powered. There will be yellow truncated domes on each ramp on each side of the crosswalk. There will also be a crosswalk warning sign further back from each crosswalk and a yield sign.

Kristin agreed with that stating that part of the exercise of the walk is to get that sort of

input and identify the gaps. Kristin said the standards for the new design is that all trails are paved.
