

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-26

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
CONSENTING TO INCLUSION OF CITY TERRITORY IN SACRAMENTO
PUBLIC LIBRARY COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1996-01, (CFD),
SACRAMENTO COUNTY AND PROPOSED ALTERATION TO THE EXISTING
RATE AND METHOD OF APPORTIONMENT OF THE SPECIAL TAX FOR THE
SACRAMENTO PUBLIC LIBRARY CFD TO IMPOSE A \$22 PER RESIDENTIAL
PARCEL SPECIAL TAX FOR A MAXIMUM 4-YR TERM TO EXPIRE NO LATER
THAN JUNE 30, 2005, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE VOTERS**

**WHEREAS, the County of Sacramento ("County") formed the Sacramento
Public Library Community Facilities District No. 1996-01 ("District") pursuant to
the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982 (Government Code Section
53311 et seq.) ("Act") and County Board of Supervisors Resolution No. 96-1261
on October 29, 1996, which District included territory now within the jurisdiction of
the City of Elk Grove;**

**WHEREAS, on July 1, 2000, the incorporation of the City of Elk Grove
("City") was effective:**

**WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 53318.5 of the Act, a
legislative body of a city shall consent to the formation of a community facilities
district which includes territory within the city's jurisdiction; and**

**WHEREAS, the County now desires to change the rate and method of
apportionment of the special tax and the services to be provided by the District;**

**WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove desires to consent to
the changes in the District.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct.

**Section 2. The City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby consents to
the inclusion of its territory within the Sacramento Public Library Community
Facilities District No. 1996-01.**


