## **RESOLUTION NO. 2000-5**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE REGARDING OFFICIAL BONDS FOR OFFICERS OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, state law provides that the City Clerk and City Treasurer, before entering upon the duties of their offices, shall execute a bond to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may require bonds of other officers or employees of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is required to fix the penal sum of the bond at a reasonable amount, after recommendation by the City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney recommends bonds in the form and amount specified below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove as follows:

- 1. The individuals who hold the offices of City Manager, City Clerk and City Treasurer shall, before entering upon their duties, execute and file official bonds in the amount and manner specified below.
  - 2. The penal sum of each bond shall be \$1,000,000.00.
- 3. The form of the bonds shall conform to the provisions of the Government Code relating to bonds of public officers.
  - 4. The City Council shall approve all bonds before they are filed.
- 5. After approval by the City Council, a bond shall be filed with the City Clerk, except that the City Clerk's bond shall be filed with the Mayor.
- 6. The official bonds shall be acquired by and the premium for the bonds paid for by the City.

7. For 30 days following incorporation, the City will accept official bonds in the name of the office, rather than in the name of the individual office holder. After that 30-day period, each individual office holder identified above will be required to execute and file a bond.
