

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-60

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE FOR DESIGN IMPROVEMENTS TO ELK GROVE BOULEVARD – ELK GROVE-FLORIN ROAD TO WATERMAN ROAD AND RAILROAD GRADE SEPARATION FEASIBILITY STUDY

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove desires to improve the Old Town Section of Elk Grove Blvd, as has been planned for several years, and for which has been created the Old Town Conceptual Master Plan, and wishes that the next phase of work be contracted to Carter Burgess, the firm that prepared the Conceptual Plan, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to have the Railroad Over Crossing Feasibility Study made in conjunction with the Old Town Elk Grove Project planning and Engineering, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council of Elk Grove that these contracts be let and administered by the County Transportation Department working as the City Transportation Department, with the coordination of the Elk Grove Director of public Works

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council approves the Scope of work, of Carter Burgess, for:


1. Design of Improvements to Elk Grove Boulevard – Elk Grove Florin to Waterman Road.
2. Railroad Grade Separation Feasibility Study

And Authorizes the work to be done by the County Department of Transportation with the coordination of the City Director of Public Works
