A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE TO VACATE THE EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF VEHICULAR INGRESS AND/OR EGRESS ACROSS A PORTION OF HARBOUR POINT DRIVE AND/OR ACROSS A PORTION OF ELK GROVE BOULEVARD

WHEREAS, the City received a petition to vacate from owners of property within the City of Elk Grove requesting the City Council of the City of Elk Grove to consider vacation of the subject property; and Non the to 19

WHEREAS, a notice that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove would consider the proposed vacation at a Public Hearing was given in compliance with California Streets and Highways Code, Section 8300, et*seq.; and-

WHEREAS, the standards and procedures provided in the Public Streets. Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law, California Streets and Highways Code Section 8300 et seq, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby declares its intention to vacate portions of a restricted vehicular access easement along the easterly Right-of-Way line of Harbour Point Drive and along the northeasterly Right-of-Way line of Elk Grove Boulevard on Assessor's Parcel No. 119-0120-134, created by that certain Parcel Map No. 01-0778 as filed in Book 165 of Parcel Maps at Page 7, Official Records of Sacramento, California, specifically shown on the attached Exhibits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove Planning Department has reviewed this project and is recommending that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove find said vacation as described in the attached exhibits exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15305 of the CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove Planning Department has determined that the vacation is consistent with the General Plan and all elements thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove, a political subdivision of the State of California that this City Council hereby finds as follows:

- a. That said vacation would be consistent with, and not violate the General Plan and all elements and components thereof for the City of Elk Grove; and
- b. That the Exclusive Right of Ingress and Egress is no longer needed in these locations because the City has approved a site plan that allows for new driveway locations and the remaining frontage has existing ingress and egress restrictions in place; and
- c. That the public interest will be served by the herein vacation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Exclusive Right of Ingress and Egress over portions of the property as described in the attached Exhibit "A" – Legal Description, "B" - Plat are hereby vacated.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City Clerk of the Elk Grove City Council shall cause a certified copy of this Resolution of Vacation, attested by the Clerk under seal, to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Sacramento.


