Subject: Application for the Used Oil Recycling Block Grant (11th Cycle) Fiscal Year 2005/2006 (UBG11)

<u>APPLICATION</u>: To simplify the application process, a partially completed application form is included based on information submitted in your UBG10 application. If you did not apply for the 10^{th} cycle, you will receive a blank application.

Note: Page 2 of the application has been removed and will now be incorporated into the Annual Report, in order to better facilitate spending projections of all Block Grant activities.

ADVANCE PAYMENT MODIFICATIONS

Beginning with UBG11, grant funds will be expended on a reimbursement basis only for grants over \$20,000. This eliminates the interest-tracking requirement for advanced payments. Staff will consider exceptions to the reimbursement policy for financial hardship situations on a case-by-case basis.

For Grantees receiving \$20,000 or less, and multi-jurisdictional and regional grantees whose individual jurisdictions would have received \$20,000 or less had they applied individually – the advance payment option is available.

To be eligible to *apply* for a Used Oil Block Grant (Block Grant), local governments must:

- Have a complete and approved 2004 Annual Report;
- Submit a completed Annual Report by August 15, 2005 (for all previous grant cycles, if active), and
- Have either one certified collection center per 100,000 residents or a curbside collection program which includes used oil collection.

To be eligible to receive a Block Grant, local governments must:

- submit a timely, completed application package;
- have current and approved Annual Reports, if applicable;
- return the executed Grant Agreement within ninety (90) days of the date of mailing by the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB); and,
- pay in full, within ninety (90) days from the date of the award, all outstanding debt(s) owed by the proposed Grantee to the CIWMB.

NOTICE TO PROCEED: As a policy, the Used Oil Program sends a legal notification, called a Notice to Proceed, to all Grantees, which provides the effective date you are authorized to begin incurring costs related to your grant. The Notice to Proceed for UBG11 is expected to be shortly after the 2005/2006
