**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby accepts the Big Horn Boulevard/New Country Drive Traffic Signal System Project as complete.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes and directs the City Engineer to file a Notice of Completion for the Big Horn Boulevard/New Country Drive Traffic Signal System Project with the Sacramento County Recorder.
