**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006
TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT (TDA) CLAIM TO THE SACRAMENTO
AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS**


WHEREAS, the State of California enacted the Transportation Development Act (TDA) in 1972 to provide funds for transportation needs each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) is designated as the Regional Transportation Planning Agency for the City of Elk Grove to receive claims for approval pursuant to the TDA rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, SACOG has adopted funding of apportionment for Local Transportation Funds and State Transit Assistance (STA) Funds for Fiscal Year 2005-2006; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 TDA Claim is hereby approved for submission to SACOG and the City Manager, or his designee is hereby authorized to make the necessary budget amendments, transfers, and accounting entries to carry out the City Council's policies and directives related to this matter.
