

**RESOLUTION NO. 2005-332**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE INCREASING THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE REAL ESTATE RELATED CONTRACTS AND DOCUMENTS FOR THE BOND ROAD WIDENING PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, improving and widening Bond Road holds a high priority in the City of Elk Grove Transportation Capital Improvement Program and acquiring the necessary right of way and assisting with the required business relocation are important and necessary steps in completing the Bond Road Widening Project; and


**WHEREAS**, widening and reconstruction of the 1.5 mile stretch of roadway requires acquisition of a portion of twenty-two (22) properties and one business relocation; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 21, 2004, the City Council authorized the City Manager, or his designee, to execute real estate related contracts and documents, total compensation for which was not to exceed \$825,000; and


**WHEREAS**, additional contract authority is needed to complete the required business relocation; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby increases the authority of the City Manager, or his designee, to execute contracts and documents for the acquisition of right of way and relocation assistance for those properties affected by the Bond Road Widening Project from an amount not to exceed \$825,000 to an amount not to exceed \$1,150,000.


