
**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,000,000 FROM
THE GENERAL FUND UNRESERVED TO THE GENERAL FUND RESERVE FOR
POLICE SERVICES FUND BALANCE FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT CAPITAL AND
TRANSITION COSTS**

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need for police capital and transition costs in the City of Elk Grove, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Elk Grove wishes to transfer funds for the police department reserve the amount of \$4,000,000, from the General Fund Unreserved Account to the General Fund Police Reserve for police department services for the future acquisition of capital facilities and transition costs in the City of Elk Grove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove that the amount of \$4,000,000 is transferred from the General Fund Unreserved Account to General Fund Police Reserve Account.




