**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AND
THE SACRAMENTO TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY REGARDING THE
SACRAMENTO TRANSPORTATION AND AIR QUALITY COLLABORATIVE**

WHEREAS, continued participation in the Sacramento Transportation and Air Quality Collaborative by the City of Elk Grove promotes a regional approach to the transportation and air quality issues facing Sacramento County; and

WHEREAS, the City's pro rata share will not exceed \$22,850 and will be funded through Gas Tax Funds (Transportation Program Management).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager, or his designee, to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (covering the period from July 1 to December 31, 2005) between the Sacramento Transportation Authority and the City of Elk Grove regarding the Sacramento Transportation and Air Quality Collaborative.




