- WHEREAS, Preserve America is a White House initiative developed in cooperation with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, the U.S. Department of the Interior, and the U.S. Department of Commerce; and
- WHEREAS, the goals of this initiative include a greater shared knowledge about our Nation's past, strengthened regional identities and local pride, increased local participation in preserving the country's irreplaceable cultural and natural heritage assets, and support for the economic vitality of communities; and
- **WHEREAS**, this initiative is compatible with the City of Elk Grove's interests and goals related to historic preservation; and
- **WHEREAS**, designation as a Preserve America Community will improve the City of Elk Grove's ability to protect and promote its historical resources; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's General Plan has a Historic Resources Element that lays out recommended policies to help provide additional protections to historic resources; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove, as described in the Preserve America application, protects and celebrates the City heritage, uses historic assets for economic development and community revitalization, and encourages people to experience and appreciate local historic resources; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove desires to continue to protect and celebrate our heritage, to use our historic assets for economic development and community revitalization, and to encourage people to experience and appreciate local historic resources through education and heritage tourism programs.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign and submit an application to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation in Washington DC to apply for the designation of the City of Elk Grove as a Preserve America Community.
