NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby rejects the bid received for the Bruceville Road/KinderCare Frontage Improvements and the Elk Grove Boulevard Widening Adjacent to Sabrina Lane Project and authorizes the City Engineer to re-bid the project.
