#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2007-161**

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF THE SPECIAL TAX IN THE CITY OF ELK GROVE COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 2003-2 (POLICE SERVICES) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007-08

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove (the "Council") on November 5, 2003, duly adopted its Resolution No. 2003-214 (the "Resolution") establishing the City of Elk Grove Community Facilities District No. 2003-2 (Police Services) (the "CFD") for the purpose of providing for the financing of certain facilities and services in and for the CFD and providing for the levy of a special tax in and for the CFD;

WHEREAS, at an election held in the CFD on November 5, 2003, the qualified electors duly authorized the levy and collection of a special tax to be used for the purpose of paying the costs of the facilities and services;

WHEREAS, the Council, on November 5, 2003, adopted its Ordinance No. 41-2003 (the "Ordinance") levying the special tax in CFD;

**WHEREAS**, the Council has authorized annexed property in to the CFD since its formation on November 5, 2003;

**WHEREAS**, following each annexation, the Council adopted an ordinance (the "Annexation Ordinances") levying the special tax in the territory annexed to the CFD;

WHEREAS, there has been submitted to the Council a special tax roll, which is on file with the City Clerk (the "Special Tax Roll"), for the CFD for Fiscal Year 2007-08, which lists all parcels subject to the special tax levy and includes the amount of the special tax to be levied on each parcel, which amounts reflect rates that do not exceed the rates provided by the Ordinance;

WHEREAS, summary information regarding the special taxes to be levied for Fiscal Year 2007-08 is attached as Exhibit A hereto;

WHEREAS, the Council has determined to levy the special tax at the rates specified in the Special Tax Roll and to apportion them in the manner specified in the Resolution;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove that:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Recitals</u>. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and this Council so finds and determines.

Resolution No. 2007-161 Page 1 of 6 <u>Section 2</u>. <u>Levy of Special Tax</u>. Pursuant to section 53340 of the Government Code of the State of California, the special tax is hereby levied at the rates specified in the Special Tax Roll and is hereby apportioned in the manner specified in the Resolution (and reflected in the Special Tax Roll).

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Adjustments to the Special Tax Roll</u>. The CFD Administrator is hereby authorized to make changes to the Special Tax Roll prior to the final posting of the special taxes to the County tax roll, in response to appeals from taxpayers, or otherwise to achieve a correct match of the special tax levy with the assessor's parcel numbers finally utilized by the County in sending out property tax bills or in order to correct errors that may, from time to time, arise in the application of the special tax to particular parcels.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Tax Collection</u>. Pursuant to section 53340 of the Government Code of the State of California, the special tax shall be collected by the Director of Finance of the County of Sacramento in the same manner as ordinary <u>ad valorem</u> property taxes are collected and shall be subject to the same procedure, sale, and lien priority in case of delinquency as is provided for <u>ad valorem</u> taxes, subject to all other conditions set forth in the Resolution.

<u>Section 5</u> <u>Filing the Special Tax Roll</u>. In order to have the special tax levied hereby collected in the next tax collection period and thus available to finance the facilities approved by the electors of the CFD, the CFD Administrator shall deliver a certified copy of the Special Tax Roll to the Director of Finance of the County of Sacramento by the deadline specified by the County.

<u>Section 6</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


