AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE ELK GROVE
(OLD TOWN) LIBRARY PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove purchased the office building at the corner of Elk Grove Boulevard and Elk Grove-Florin Road with the intention of converting it into a public library;

WHEREAS, a consultant contract with Group 4 Architects was executed to design the conversion and meet with the library staff and public to assure that a functional and useful library resulted; and

WHEREAS, the design is completed with public and library staff approval and the construction bid documents are complete and ready for bidding.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Engineer to call for bids for the Elk Grove (Old Town) Library Project.
