A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO EXECUTE THE SACRAMENTO TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY'S NEW MEASURE A CAPITAL ALLOCATION AND EXPENDITURE AMENDED CONTRACTS FOR THE GRANT LINE ROAD/STATE ROUTE 99 INTERCHANGE AND THE SHELDON ROAD/STATE ROUTE 99 INTERCHANGE PROJECTS AND APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15 MILLION TO TRANSFER REVENUE BETWEEN THE TWO INTERCHANGE PROJECTS TO REFLECT MODIFIED ELK GROVE ROADWAY FEE AND NEW MEASURE A FUNDING

WHEREAS, in November 2004, voters approved an ordinance and expenditure plan to continue Sacramento County's Measure A Transportation sales tax program for a period of 30 years after the current Measure A term expires in 2009;

WHEREAS, in order to accommodate aggressive delivery schedules in the *New* Measure A Capital Program, the Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA) approved accelerating the availability of *New* Measure A funds via debt financing;

WHEREAS, the first issue of the 2006 series of revenue anticipation notes will go toward 11 Capital Projects totaling \$89.6 million in sales tax revenues;

WHEREAS, of the 11 projects in the first series of revenue anticipation notes two are the City of Elk Grove's Grant Line Road/State Route 99 Interchange Project and the Sheldon Road/State Route 99 Interchange Project;

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2006, the STA and the City of Elk Grove entered into Allocation and Expenditure Contracts identifying *New* Measure A revenue for the Grant Line Road/State Route 99 Interchange Project as \$22,229,290 and the Sheldon Road/State Route 99 Interchange Project as \$23,291,743;

WHEREAS, in order to ensure the expenditure of all *New* Measure A revenue prior to October 31, 2008, \$15,000,000 in *New* Measure A revenue was recommended by staff to be transferred from Sheldon Interchange/State Route 99 Interchange Project to the Grant Line/State Route 99 Interchange Project and the like amount of \$15,000,000 in Elk Grove Roadway Fee Revenue was recommended by staff for transfer from the Grant Line/State Route 99 Interchange Project to the Sheldon Road/State Route 99 Interchange Project;

WHEREAS, staff's recommended action necessitates an amendment to the City of Elk Grove's Fiscal Year 2007-08 budget to reflect the precise New Measure A figures

identified in these contracts and to reflect the amended Elk Grove Roadway Fee contribution to each Interchange Project; and

WHEREAS, the amended budget figures are identified in Table 2 (Attached).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- Authorizes the City Engineer to execute the Sacramento Transportation Authority's New Measure A Capital Allocation and Expenditure Amended Contracts for the Grant Line Road/State Route 99 Interchange and the Sheldon Road/State Route 99 Interchange Projects contingent upon approval by the STA Board of Directors; and
- 2. Approves an amendment to the City of Elk Grove's Fiscal Year 2007-08 Budget to the *New* Measure A and Elk Grove Roadway Fee Funds described in Table 2 (Attached).

It also then transfers \$15,000,000 in Elk Grove Roadway Fee funding from the Grant Line Road/State Route 99 Interchange Project to the Sheldon Road/State Route 99 Interchange Project to backfill the reprogramming.

Total costs for the Interchange Projects do not change.
