RESOLUTION NO. 2008-123

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ELK GROVE ADOPTING THE 2008-09 BUDGET, ADOPTING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT AND 2008-2013 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2008 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2009

WHEREAS, the City Manager has submitted the Fiscal Year 2008-09 Budget to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2008-09 Budget was prepared in accordance with the City Council's goals, Departmental Work Plans, budget assumptions and policies; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2008-09 Budget is balanced and does not require additional taxes or fees; and

WHEREAS, Article XIIIB of the California State Constitution and Government Code Section 7910 requires a City to establish its appropriation limit for each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has found the 2008-2013 Capital Improvement Plan to be consistent with the General Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby adopts the Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Operating Budget and 2008-2013 Capital Improvement Plan.

- A. The FY2008-09 Proposed Budget and 2008-2013 Proposed Capital Improvement Plan as defined in Section 2.1 are hereby approved.
- B. Sections 1 through 8 below, which define the authority and responsibilities of the City Manager in implementing the Approved Budget, are hereby approved.

SECTION 1. SCOPE

1.1 This resolution defines the authority and responsibilities of the City Manager in implementing the Approved Budget of the City of Elk Grove.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 "Approved Budget" includes the following documents:
 - (1) The FY2008-09 Proposed Budget and 2008-2013 Proposed Capital

Resolution No. 2008-123 Page 1 of 3 Improvement Plan dated May 14, 2008 as amended by the City Council.

2.2 "City Manager" means the City Manager or, if so designated, the Director of Finance or the Budget Manager.

SECTION 3. AUTHORIZED APPROPRIATIONS

- 3.1 The City Manager is authorized to make any expenditure and resource adjustments to the Approved Budget based on final City Council action to adopt the Budget.
- 3.2 The City Manager is authorized to establish the appropriations as indicated in the budget and staffing as shown in schedules contained in exhibit A.
- 3.3 Operating appropriation transfers within the same department and fund must be approved by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. STAFFING INCREASES/DECREASES

4.1 Any increase or decrease, by department by fund, in staffing as authorized in the Approved or Amended Budget for a department must be approved by the City Council.

SECTION 5. UNSPENT APPROPRIATIONS AND ENCUMBRANCES

- 5.1 All appropriations in the operating budget, which remain unencumbered or unexpended on June 30, 2008, shall revert to the fund balance of the respective funds.
- 5.2 All purchase order commitments outstanding on June 30, 2008 and associated appropriations are hereby continued.

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION LIMITS

- 6.1 The appropriation limit and the appropriations subject to the limit are hereby amended pursuant to Article XIIIB of the California Constitution for FY2007/08 as detailed in exhibit B.
- 6.2 That the appropriation limitation established for the 2008-09 fiscal year shall be \$65,291,591 and the adopted 2008-09 fiscal year budget has not exceeded the appropriation limit.
- 6.3 Elect the growth in per capita income increase calculation method as the inflation factor for the 2008-09 fiscal year.
- 6.4 The actual appropriation for fiscal year ended 2007-08 has not exceeded the appropriation limitation that was adopted for the 2007-08 fiscal year.

SECTION 7. MIDYEAR FINANCIAL REPORT

7.1 The City Council shall be provided a Midyear Financial Report including a revised estimate of the financial condition of all funds, prior year actual fund balances, revised estimated revenues and expenditures, projected ending fund balances or deficits, and recommendations for eliminating any projected fund deficits.

SECTION 8. MISCELLANEOUS CONTROLS/CONSIDERATIONS

- 8.1 No expenditures at the department level shall exceed the Approved or Amended Budget, by fund .
- 8.2 The City Manager is authorized to adjust budgets in the Capital Project funds for the current year based on previous actions of City Council for projects on a multi-year basis.
