A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY VIA THE SACRAMENTO DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE TO CONTINUE IMPLEMENTATION OF "BEFORE THE IMPACT," A DRIVING SAFETY PROGRAM, IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$77,500 AND INCREASE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S REVENUE AND EXPENSE **BUDGET BY THE ACTUAL AMOUNT RECEIVED**

WHEREAS, the California Office of Traffic Safety provides grant funding to encourage law enforcement agencies to work together on countywide efforts to discourage those who may engage in risky driving behaviors; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento District Attorney's Office received a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety to provide community awareness and education that will reduce the number of fatalities related to teenage and adult drivers; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento District Attorney's Office has selected the Elk Grove Police Department as its partner agency to continue bringing driving safety education and awareness to teens and adults; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department has agreed to continue its partnership with the Sacramento District Attorney's Office by offering a full-time Community Services Officer that will be responsible for delivering "Before the Impact" a driving safety education and awareness program for teens and adults.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to: 1) accept an appropriation from the California Office of Traffic Safety via the Sacramento District Attorney's Office to continue implementation of "Before the Impact" a driving safety program, in an amount not to exceed \$77,500; and 2) increase the Police Department's revenue and expense budget by the actual amount received.
