A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH
NBS GOVERNMENT FINANCE GROUP FOR FINANCING DISTRICT
ADMINISTRATION, ARBITRAGE REBATE AND CONTINUING DISCLOSURE
SERVICES WITH THREE OPTIONAL ONE YEAR EXTENSIONS FOR A TOTAL
COMPENSATION AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$520,000

WHEREAS, the current financing district services contract has a termination date of February 28, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.140 requires competitive bidding through a formal Request for Proposal (RFP) procedure; and

WHEREAS, multiple proposals were received and evaluated; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposal submitted by NBS Government Finance Group is the most responsive and offered extensive regional public sector experience; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are appropriated in the FY 2014-15 Budget of the various project funds to pay for such professional services as needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the financing district services contract with NBS Government Finance Group for a term of three years with three optional one year extensions. The Consultant shall be paid per Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, for annual administration and other services. Total compensation paid to Consultant under this contract, shall not exceed \$520,000. Fiscal Year 2014-15 monies are appropriated for such services within the current budget. Future costs for services will be addressed in future budgets.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to take all action and execute all documents reasonably necessary to implement the contract.
