## **RESOLUTION NO. 2015-228**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION TO IMPLEMENT A STRATEGIC ENFORCEMENT INITIATIVE AS PART OF THE ORGANIZED CRIME DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE AND AMEND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000 IF AWARDED

WHEREAS, the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration oversees the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Forces (OCDETF), a program whose mission is to identify, disrupt, and dismantle drug trafficking and money laundering organizations through cooperative measures; and

WHEREAS, OCDETF has requested the cooperation of the Elk Grove Police Department in a strategic enforcement initiative that will require officers to work periodic overtime: and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department continues to be an active partner with the DEA and other law enforcement agencies in the eradication of illegal drugs; and

WHEREAS, OCDETF has agreed to reimburse the Elk Grove Police Department for up to \$25,000 for overtime hours worked by officers participating in this initiative; and

WHEREAS, this initiative supports City Council's goal to grow and support safe, livable, attractive neighborhoods.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby adopts a resolution authorizing the City Manager to:

- 1) Apply for grant funding from the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration in the amount of \$25,000 for the purpose of implementing a strategic enforcement initiative; and
- 2) Accept program funding from the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration in the amount of \$25,000 for the purpose of implementing a strategic enforcement initiative if awarded; and
- 3) Execute all related documents required for receiving such funds pursuant to the terms and conditions of the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration; and
- 4) Upon the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration's award of the grant funding. amend the Police Department's revenue and expense budget each fiscal year in the total amount of \$25,000 until all funds are expended
