

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-241

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE
US DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION TO
IMPLEMENT A STRATEGIC ENFORCEMENT INITIATIVE AS A PART OF THE
ORGANIZED CRIME DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE AND AMEND THE
POLICE DEPARTMENT'S BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000**

WHEREAS, the US Drug Enforcement Administration oversees the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Forces (OCDETF), a program whose mission is to identify, disrupt, and dismantle drug trafficking and money laundering organization through cooperative measures; and

WHEREAS, OCDETF has requested the cooperation of the Elk Grove Police Department in a strategic enforcement initiative that will require officers to work periodic overtime; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department submitted a successful grant application in the amount of \$10,000 which will assist the Narcotics Team in investigating and eradicating illegal drug operations in the City of Elk Grove; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department continues to be an active partner with the DEA and other law enforcement agencies in the eradication of illegal drugs; and

WHEREAS, this grant is designed to reimburse overtime costs incurred by officers working full-time on OCDETF cases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to:

- 1) Apply for grant funding from the US Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration in the amount of \$10,000 for the purpose of implementing a strategic enforcement initiative; and
- 2) Execute all related documents required for receiving such funds pursuant to the terms and conditions of the US Drug Enforcement Administration, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney; and
- 3) Amend the Police Department's revenue and expense budget each fiscal year in the total amount of \$10,000 until all funds are expended.


