A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE SENATE BILL 1 STATE OF GOOD REPAIR PROJECT LIST FOR THE FY 2020-21 FUNDING ALLOCATION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO MAKE ANY NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS, AMENDMENTS, OR REVISIONS TO TRANSIT'S FISCAL YEAR OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS TO ACCOMMODATE THE CURRENT STATE OF GOOD REPAIR PROGRAM FUNDING ALLOCATION AND ANY FUTURE REVISIONS TO THE FUNDING ALLOCATION

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, establishes the State of Good Repair (SGR) program to fund eligible transit maintenance, rehabilitation and capital project activities that maintain the public transit system in a state of good repair with State Transit Assistance (STA) account funds; and

WHEREAS, SGR-STA funds are apportioned by the State Controller's Office and allocated by the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG); and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's current allocation of SGR-STA program funds for Fiscal Year 2020-21 is estimated to be \$264,183; and

WHEREAS, these SGR-STA program funds will be used for the project identified in Exhibit A of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, in order to qualify for these funds, the City of Elk Grove is required to submit a proposed project list to the California Department of Transportation (Caltans) on an annual basis by September 1 of each year; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is authorized to submit a request for the scheduled allocation of the SB 1 State of Good Repair program funds, and to execute the related grant applications, forms, and agreements, and any amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the Certification and Assurances document and applicable statutes, regulations and guidelines for all SGR funded transit capital projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby approves the SB 1 State of Good Repair Project List, attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, for the FY 2020-21 funding allocation.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to make any necessary adjustments, amendments, or revisions to Transit's fiscal year operating and capital budgets to accommodate the current FY 2020-21 SGR program funding allocation and any future revisions thereto.
