## **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-200**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE FY2021 CITYWIDE CRACK SEAL PROJECT (OM2101); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH GLOBAL ROAD SEALING, INC. FOR THE FY2021 CITYWIDE CRACK SEAL PROJECT (OM2101) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$628,863.96; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$31,400 (CEQA EXEMPT)

**WHEREAS**, the FY2021 Citywide Crack Seal Project (OM2101) (Project) will result in placement of crack seal treatment on various roads throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on July 10, 2020, and July 17, 2020, and bids were opened on August 4, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, Global Road Sealing, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. As the Project involves repair/maintenance to existing public roadways and will involve no expansion of use, it qualifies for the identified exemption and no additional environmental review under CEQA is required.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Approves the Project; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Global Road Sealing, Inc. for the FY2021 Citywide Crack Seal Treatment Project (OM2101) in the amount of \$628,863.96 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$31,400.
