

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-027**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ACCEPTING THE SLEEPY HOLLOW DETENTION BASIN RETROFIT PROJECT (WDR013) AS COMPLETE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE AND THE CITY CLERK TO FILE THE NOTICE OF COMPLETION WITH THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY RECORDER; AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO AMEND THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BY REDUCING THE REMAINING PROJECT BUDGET AUTHORITY TO ZERO AND RETURNING ANY REMAINING FUNDS BACK TO THEIR RESPECTIVE FUND(S)**

**WHEREAS**, on July 26, 2017, the City Council authorized the award of a construction contract to Martin Brothers Construction for the Sleepy Hollow Detention Basin Retrofit Project (WDR013); and

**WHEREAS**, the Project included the retrofit of an approximately 7-acre existing detention basin located just south of Calvine Road between Bader Road and Excelsior Road, including clearing and grubbing, earthwork, infiltration trench, irrigation, site preparation, planting, seeding, and plant establishment; and

**WHEREAS**, Martin Brothers Construction has completed the work in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract documents for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, if no liens or claims have been filed within 35 days of filing the Notice of Completion, the retained payment funds and any remaining amount due will be released to Martin Brothers Construction; and

**WHEREAS**, post construction work is typically completed within 120 days of the City Clerk filing the Notice of Completion with the Sacramento County Recorder and then all invoices can be paid.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:


- 1) Accepts the Sleepy Hollow Detention Basin Retrofit Project (WDR013) as complete;
- 2) Authorizes the City Engineer to prepare a Notice of Completion and the City Clerk to file the Notice of Completion for the Project with the Sacramento County Recorder; and
- 3) Authorizes staff to amend the Annual Budget and Capital Improvement Program by reducing the remaining project budget authority to zero and returning any remaining funds back to their respective fund(s).


