

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-120

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ACCEPTING THE SHELDON ROAD BIKE LANES AND TURN LANES PROJECT (WTR054) AS COMPLETE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE AND THE CITY CLERK TO FILE THE NOTICE OF COMPLETION WITH THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY RECORDER; AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO AMEND THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BY REDUCING THE REMAINING PROJECT BUDGET AUTHORITY TO ZERO AND RETURNING ANY REMAINING FUNDS BACK TO THEIR RESPECTIVE FUND(S)

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2020, the City Council authorized the award of a construction contract to Teichert & Son, Inc. (dba Teichert Construction), for the Sheldon Road Bike Lanes and Turn Lanes Project (WTR054); and

WHEREAS, the Project included repair of heavily distressed HMA areas, by replacing the full structural section in approximately 20 percent of the rehabilitation area. The Project also included a grind and inlay with paving fabric, localized widening to accommodate a two-way left turn lane plus bike lane, and new striping for Sheldon Road with new localized two-way left turn lane pockets from Scenic Elk Court to Armaria Court; and

WHEREAS, Teichert & Son, Inc. (dba Teichert Construction) has completed the work in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract documents for the Project; and

WHEREAS, if no liens or claims have been filed within 35 days of filing the Notice of Completion, the retained payment funds and any remaining amount due will be released to Teichert & Son, Inc. (dba Teichert Construction); and

WHEREAS, post construction work is typically completed within 120 days of the City Clerk filing the Notice of Completion with the Sacramento County Recorder and then all invoices can be paid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Accepts the Sheldon Road Bike Lanes and Turn Lanes Project (WTR054) as complete;
- 2) Authorizes the City Engineer to prepare a Notice of Completion and the City Clerk to file the Notice of Completion for the Project with the Sacramento County Recorder; and
- 3) Authorizes staff to amend the Annual Budget and Capital Improvement Program by reducing the remaining project budget authority to zero and returning any remaining funds back to their respective fund(s).


