

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-185

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE THERMOPLASTIC STRIPING (SPRAY) PROJECT (OM2115); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MAINTENANCE CONTRACT WITH APPLY-A-LINE, LLC FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$97,980; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$9,798; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MAINTENANCE CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS. (CEQA EXEMPT)

WHEREAS, the Thermoplastic Striping (Spray) Project (OM2115) (Project) will result in thermoplastic striping (spray) and markings on various streets throughout the City, as presented in the Project Locations Maps; and

WHEREAS, the Project was posted to the City of Elk Grove Vendor Portal on April 28, 2021; an invitation to bid was duly advertised on May 7, 2021, and May 14, 2021; and electronic bids were received on May 25, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Apply-A-Line, LLC was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, Chrisp Company was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the second lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA), which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, Section 15301(c) (Class 1 Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. As the Project involves application of thermoplastic striping (spray) and markings on existing streets throughout the City, there is no expansion of use. Therefore, the Project qualifies for the identified exemption and no additional environmental review under CEQA is required; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Approves the Project; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a maintenance contract with Apply-A-Line, LLC for the Thermoplastic Spray (Striping) Project (OM2115) in the amount of \$97,978 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and,
- 3) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$9,798 and,

- 4) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a maintenance contract with the second lowest responsive bidder, Chrisp Company, if Apply-A-Line, LLC, does not meet filing obligations.
