## **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-221**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE 2021 PAVEMENT SLURRY SEAL AND RESURFACING PROJECT (WPR021) (REBID); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH VSS INTERNATIONAL, INC. FOR THE 2021 PAVEMENT SLURRY SEAL AND RESURFACING PROJECT (WPR021) (REBID) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$882,000; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$132,000; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS. (CEQA EXEMPT)

**WHEREAS**, the 2021 Pavement Slurry Seal and Resurfacing Project (WPR021) (REBID) (Project) will consist of the following work: place slurry seal, micro-surfacing, multi-layer treatment system, repair asphalt pavement, and stripe various streets throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on July 2, 2021, and July 9, 2021, and electronic bids were received on July 15, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, VSS International, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, Pavement Coatings Co. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the second lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. The Project involves slurry seal, micro-surfacing, multi-layer treatment system, asphalt pavement repair, and striping various streets throughout the City. As these proposed alterations and modifications would occur within existing City-owned facilities, would not expand the existing use of these facilities, and would not have a significant effect on the environment, the Project qualifies for the identified exemption. No further environmental review under CEQA is required; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2021-26 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2021-22 Budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

1) Approves the Project; and

- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with VSS International, Inc. for the 2021 Pavement Slurry Seal and Resurfacing Project (WPR021) (REBID) in the amount of \$882,000 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and,
- 3) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$132,000; and,
- 4) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest responsive bidder, Pavement Coatings Co., if, VSS International, Inc., does not meet filing obligations;
