A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE SUPPORTING THE PLACEMENT OF A PROPOSED TAX MEASURE ON THE NOVEMBER 2022 BALLOT TO CONTINUE THE SACRAMENTO ABANDONED VEHICLE SERVICE AUTHORITY (SAVSA) VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEE, AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 BUDGET, ALLOCATING \$34,816 TO SAVSA TO DEFRAY COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PLACING THE MEASURE ON THE BALLOT

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Abandoned Vehicle Service Authority (SAVSA) was created in 1992, and its members include jurisdictions in Sacramento County that perform abandoned vehicle abatement, and is overseen by the Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA); and

WHEREAS, SAVSA sunsets every ten (10) years, with the next sunset occurring in April 2022; and

WHEREAS, SAVSA oversees a financing mechanism that results in the collection of \$1 on each Sacramento County vehicle registration through the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and provides reimbursement for abandoned vehicle abatement costs to participating agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove joined SAVSA in 2003 and most recently receives approximately \$150,000 annually for the reimbursement of abandoned vehicle abatement costs; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by SAVSA that the April 2022 sunset cannot be renewed without a two-thirds majority approval by voters, with Elk Grove's share of the election costs being \$34,816; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove desires to support the placement of a measure on the November 2022 ballot extending the authorization to collect the \$1 fee on Sacramento vehicle registrations, and in turn continue the SAVSA program providing reimbursement of abandoned vehicle abatement costs to participating agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove as follows:

- The City Council supports the placement of a proposed tax measure on the November 2022 ballot to continue the Sacramento Abandoned Vehicle Service Authority (SAVSA) vehicle registration fee; and
- 2) The City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby approves an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Budget for the allocation of \$34,816 to SAVSA to defray a portion of costs associated with placing the above-referenced tax measure on the November 2022 ballot; specifically, the approval of this amendment increases expenditure appropriations in the Code Enforcement Other Expenses (1013540-5171299) account line within the General Fund by \$34,816.
