WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Roadway Fee Program outlines the terms and methodology for applying development impact fees for new development, based on the impact of new development on public facilities infrastructure within the City of Elk Grove; and

WHEREAS, Meeks Storage is planning to construct a new, one-story, $\pm 43,200$ square foot prefabricated metal structure for the storage of lumber materials at the project site located at 10547 East Stockton Boulevard, APN 134-1080-004; and

WHEREAS, construction of the structure will not generate new traffic nor contribute to traffic impacts on public facilities identified in the Elk Grove Roadway Fee Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the waiver of Roadway Impact Fees for the Meeks Storage project in the amount of $\$ 241,710$.
