ORDINANCE NO. 12-2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AMENDING ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 10.48 (SPEED ZONES) TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMITS ON KAMMERER ROAD

WHEREAS, with certain exceptions for prima facie speed limits for certain roadways, the California Vehicle Code (CVC) requires speed limits to be set by ordinance on the basis of an Engineering and Traffic Survey; and

WHEREAS, the California Vehicle Code (CVC) section 22358 allows Local Agencies to change local speed limits by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Engineer, consistent with state law, has performed an engineering and traffic survey for each of the street segments listed below and such surveys are attached hereto as Exhibit A and Exhibit B, and are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, in order for law enforcement to use radar and lidar to enforce speed limits, a new speed limit must be set and posted in conformance with a new engineering and traffic survey.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Purpose and Authority

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Elk Grove Municipal Code Chapter 10.48 Speed Zones to revise speed limits on Kammerer Road between Bruceville Road and Lotz Parkway, and Kammerer Road between Lotz Parkway and State Route 99.

Section 2: Findings

On May 24, 2023, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove reviewed and considered the Engineering and Traffic Surveys and related information, attached hereto as Exhibit A and Exhibit B, and incorporated herein by reference. Copies are also on file with the City's Department of Public Works.

Based on the review of the engineering and traffic speed surveys, the City Council finds that the most appropriate speed limit to facilitate the orderly movement of traffic which is reasonable and safe on the following roads to be as follows:

- Kammerer Road between Bruceville Road and Lotz Parkway is 55 MPH
- Kammerer Road between Lotz Parkway and State Route 99 is 55 MPH

Section 3: Declaration of Speed Limits

The City Council hereby declares that the speed limits shall be set in accordance with the findings and recommendations provided in Section 2 above.

Section 4: Direction to City Engineer

On or after the effective date of this ordinance, the City Engineer is directed to clearly post, or cause to be posted, speed limit signs effectuating Section 2, above, to give notice that this ordinance is in effect.

Section 5: Amendment to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 10.48.020 Speed Limits

Additions are shown in **bold**; deletions are shown in strikethrough

Section 10.48.020of the Elk Grove Municipal shall be amended to read as follows:

10.48.020 Speed limits.

. . .

F. A speed limit of fifty (50 mph) miles per hour shall apply to the following streets:

...

2. Kammerer Road between Bruceville Road and State Route 99.

G. A speed limit of fifty-five (55 mph) miles per hour shall apply to the following streets:

- 1. Kammerer Road between Bruceville Road and Lotz Parkway
- 2. Kammerer Road between Lotz Parkway and State Route 99

Section 6: No Mandatory Duty of Care.

This ordinance is not intended to and shall not be construed or given effect in a manner that imposes upon the City or any officer or employee thereof a mandatory duty of care towards persons and property within or without the City, so as to provide a basis of civil liability for damages, except as otherwise imposed by law.

Section 7: Severability.

If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable. This City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this ordinance irrespective of the invalidity of any particular portion thereof and intends that the invalid portions should be severed and the balance of the ordinance be enforced.

Section 8: Savings Clause

The provisions of this ordinance shall not affect or impair an act done or right vested or approved or any proceeding, suit or prosecution had or commenced in any cause before such repeal shall take effect; but every such act done, or right vested or accrued, or proceeding, suit or prosecution shall remain in full force and effect to all intents and purposes as if such ordinance or part thereof so repealed had remained in force. No offense committed and no liability, penalty or forfeiture, either civilly or criminally incurred prior to the time when any such ordinance or part thereof shall be repealed or altered by said Code shall be discharged or affected by such repeal or alteration; but prosecutions and suits for such offenses, liabilities, penalties or forfeitures shall be instituted and proceeded with in all respects as if such prior ordinance or part thereof had not been repealed or altered.

Section 9: Effective Date and Publication

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. In lieu of publication of the full text of the ordinance within fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary of the ordinance may be published at least five (5) days prior to and fifteen (15) days after adoption by the City Council and a certified copy shall be posted in the office of the City Clerk, pursuant to GC 36933(c)(1).



Discussion:

Kammerer Road is a three-lane arterial in the City of Elk Grove. The adjacent land uses are primarily agricultural. The roadway has two striped travel lanes with edge lines and a median / two-way left turn lane in the middle. There are no dedicated bicycle lanes or pedestrian facilities.

The road is currently posted at 55 MPH.

Prevailing Speeds:

A radar measuring device was used to establish the free flow speed along Kammerer Road on May 2, 2023. The 85% (prevailing) speed was measured at 59 MPH.

The survey form is attached.

Collision History:

Between 1/1/20 and 12/31/22 the collision rate for this segment of Kammerer Road was 0.05 collision/MVM (million vehicle miles traveled).

Recommendation:

Keep the existing speed limit of 55 MPH. This recommendation is based on the 59 MPH prevailing speed rounded up to 60 MPH and then applying a 5 MPH reduction in compliance with Section 2B.13 of the 2014 California Manual on Traffic Control Devices, Revision 6 (effective 3/30/21).

ESTABLISHED SPEED LIMIT 55 MPH



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Discussion:

Kammerer Road is a three-lane to seven-lane arterial in the City of Elk Grove. The adjacent land uses to the north are single-family homes and Sky River Casino. The western portion of the roadway has two striped travel lanes with edge lines and a median / two-way left turn lane in the middle. To the east, the roadway has seven lanes. There are dedicated bicycle lanes.

The road is currently posted at 50 and 55 MPH.

Prevailing Speeds:

A radar measuring device was used to establish the free flow speed along Kammerer Road on March 9, 2023. The 85% (prevailing) speed was measured at 57 MPH.

The survey form is attached.

<u>Collision History:</u> Between 1/1/20 and 12/31/22 there were no reported speed related collision on this segment of Kammerer Road.

Recommendation:

Increase the speed limit to 55 MPH. This recommendation is based on the 57 MPH prevailing speed rounded to the nearest 5 MPH increment.

ESTABLISHED SPEED LIMIT 55 MPH
