**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR
FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2002 TO PROVIDE FUNDS
FOR LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY SERVICES WITH THE
FIRM OF GREENBERG TRAURIG, LLP**

WHEREAS, the City Council appropriated \$70,000 in the City of Elk Grove Fiscal Year Budget 2001-02 for legislative advocacy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove wishes to contract for the services of Greenberg Traurig, LLP, to represent the legislative interests of the City of Elk Grove at the federal level; and


WHEREAS, the cumulative expenditure for State and Federal Lobbyist services by the firms of Gonsalves & Sons and Greenberg Traurig, LLP, will exceed the \$70,000 appropriation by \$7,500 during the term of the contracts in fiscal year 2001-02; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide sufficient funding for the Greenberg Traurig, LLP, contract during the 2001-02 fiscal year, it is necessary to amend the budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove does hereby approve the budget amendment in the amount of \$7,500 from the 2001-02 Fiscal Year Budget General Fund Reserve to Account No. 100-50511-1100 (Federal/State Lobbyists).
